What Can be Done ?



1. ICPDR could establish mechanism to detect such facilities by asking its members and prepare a inventory with other downstream countries
2. Chemical property of such facilities should be assessed in order to conduct timely and effective emergency response.
3. In this inventory, emergency action plans of facilities should be planned and identified as emergency, short, medium and long plans. States that have such facilities should immediately prepare action plans and convey delivery plans to the ICPDR.
4. Emergency Task forces should be gradually prepared for action, and stock of supplies should be kept of sufficient level.
5. In this context, ICPDR should share such information with BSC and downstream and upstream countries.
6. In case of any such accident, information desk should be established immediately which should be active during 24 hour a day.
